


WEEKLY ACTIVITIES

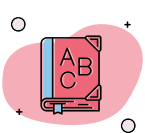

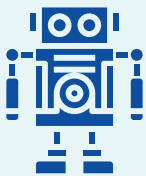
